HIGHLIGHTS:-

SCHOOL APP was launched to bring more transparency and enhanced communication with parents and community, keeping ourselves up with the pace of the modern world.

As a new endeavor, the examination result procedure replaced the conventional regime of manually prepared Reports-cards by the teachers with **Computer Generated Report-Cards**. This transformation minimized the efforts of the teachers to manually fill in the Report-Cards all by themselves.

Making our students globally relevant is need of the hour and with the same idea, we include French Language in our curriculum for grade 3 onwards.

With the sole purpose of updating teachers' knowledge, the school hosted a series of Teachers' Workshops. It was an attempt which inclusively engulfed various significant aspects like Moral Values, Life Skills and Health education.

Apart from this, our teachers are made a part of the training sessions and workshops on various ACADEMIC SUBJECTS. Attendee teachers further share the knowledge with other fellow teachers widening the sphere of wisdom. **Faculty Development Programme (FDP)** is also conducted in fortnights to enhance their language skills.

Independence day Dance Event: High School students performed cultural in VOC ground where the district collector hoisted flag function and they secured the best cultural event prize from district collector, CEO, DEO and all other important dignitaries.

Hamam Gateway Literary Competition: The Elite Circle organized ‘Hamam Gateway 2018’ as inter school literary and cultural meet for students from LKG to Grade 8 was conducted at Codissia. Twenty-one competition including drawing, colouring, caption writing, essay, thirukkural writing and group dance were organized under four groups. All the students including KG participated in all the competitions and secured 5 feet trophy and certificates for the marvelous performance rendered by our children.

Self Defense – World Record Attempt : A self defence world record was attempted by the Chaitanyans on 23rd October 2018. Students from Grade 3 -8 participated in the attempt in order to make them more self-reliant. The training would give lot of confidence to the children. The authorities observed the attempt via online and officially awarded the school after final scrutiny.

Swimming : Master Kabilan of grade II has secured three 1st prizes, one second & third prize in different styles of the swimming competition conducted by Rotary club & Aquatic association.

Karate : Ken I Ken has conducted Karate competition in which Chaitanyans' bagged two 1st places, four 2nd places and seven 3rd places. Various events like Kata, Kumite were conducted in which the students participated in State/National level and secured fourteen 1st prizes, eight 2nd prizes and ten 3rd prizes. Master Narain Nallasamy representing India, has participated in the Karate Championships 2018 by Commonwealth Karate Federation in under juniors category in South Africa at Durban.

Master Nishanth & Master Jaayesh Raghav of grade 4 Has participated in the MEIBUKAN International karate competition and secured 1st place. Master Prajesh Raghav of grade 8 has bagged the 2nd position.

Thirukkural Competition: Four students from high school got first place in drawing, Poem Composing and best hand writing. Also to proud that one staff (Ms. Suman Dev secured 1st position in tamil Poem composing and drawing.

Chess: Gowtham of grade 5 has secured the 14th position in the State level chess competition, he has also secured gold medal in the district level chess competition.

13th State level Juniors Open chess tournament was conducted, Master Harsad Mohan of grade 4 bagged the third position.
